## KEY SIGNATURES

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- Identify "Do" and "La" in all Major Keys
- Given key signature, identify major key in 3 seconds or less
- Given key signature, identify minor key in 3 seconds or less

## AURAL TRAINING

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Dictate melody in simple meter that contains:

- Stepwise motion
- Skips of a 3<sup>rd</sup>
- Skips of a 4<sup>th</sup>

Dictate rhythm in simple meter that contains:

- Quarter, half, and whole notes
- 8<sup>th</sup> notes
- 16<sup>th</sup> notes
- Dotted quarter notes
- Dotted 8<sup>th</sup> notes

## OTHER

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In an open choral score, identify the following:

- Root, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and doublings for triads in root position
- Root, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and doublings for triads in an inversion
- Root, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> for chords in root position
