

HIGH SCHOOL CHORAL CONDUCTOR OPENING FOR THE 2021-2022 SEASON!

Phoenix Children's Chorus will be interviewing for a choral conducting position directing *Bravo*, a high school regional touring choir, to begin September 2021. The Phoenix Children's Chorus is a dynamic and rapidly expanding organization comprised of children in kindergarten – 12th grade in seven different ensembles. Our season typically runs from late July through May. This is a part-time position including:

- 2 hours of weekly rehearsal time (Tuesday nights at AZ School for the Arts)
- 30-minute music literacy class following rehearsal
- 6 Saturdays rehearsals (3 Fall / 3 Spring)
- Weekend Camp in Prescott for 3 days in early August
- 4 PCC mainstage concerts and some single choir performances
- Regional tour annually (March/April)
- Fall/Midseason Auditions

Candidates should be able to provide high quality instruction of healthy vocal technique, music literacy, and performance skills. Qualified candidates will hold a degree in choral conducting or choral music education, have choral conducting and teaching experience, possess dynamic rehearsal skills, a good knowledge vocal pedagogy, and the ability to interact positively with choristers, parents, and the public.
